

One of these houses will make a better home for your children.



The houses look the same. But the one on the right is timber frame and uses roughly twice the amount of timber as the house on the left, made with brick and concrete blocks. As every cubic metre of timber used in place of other building materials saves 0.8 tonne of CO₂ from being released to the atmosphere, the timber frame house saves the atmosphere from around 4 tonnes of CO₂ (about the amount produced by driving 14,000 miles). With Europe's forests growing by an area the size of Cyprus every year, using more timber is one of the most practical ways to help slow the growth of Global Warming and make a better home for your children and your children's children.
